As darkness falls, their next priority is their homework - so essential for these students who are so eager to get a good education for a better future - but so difficult without light in their homes. This all changes with their new solar lamps!

For the parents of these students, the solar lamps enable crafts and home businesses, such as tailoring, dressmaking and basketry, to be carried out during the evening hours. This brings in vital household income and less dependence on unreliable subsistence farming for the family's survival.
