PALLETS & BOXES

Two 48" x 48" pallets of Heat Treated wood were kindly made and donated by David of Quality Box in Duncan.

Boxes were purchased online and delivered by courier to Nanoose Bay. We were ready to start.



Early in the morning, items were collected from storage & removed from the hall cupboard



BEAUTIFUL CLOTHING, BLANKETS & TOYS

These donations, lovingly made by Tumaini Fund Canada Crafters and Friends, were laid out on tables in the hall. Hours and hours of dedicated work by caring volunteers all over Canada.





Tumaini volunteers began to systematically pack, record and weigh each box.



PACKING BOXES

We carefully lined each box with plastic and packed as tightly as possible and celebrated when Box No 1 was filled with beautiful hand sewn dresses and closed and sealed.



As we steadily packed, amazingly, the piles of blankets and clothing began to diminish into a neat pile of boxes.



We realized we could get just about everything on 1 pallet and by 4pm all the tables were clear and we were finished.

With a perilous journey to Tanzania ahead, the pallet loaded with boxes was blessed by Reverend Selinde. Our prayers are our insurance for a safe journey and arrival in Kagera.
